City spatial data include addresses, fire hydrants, police beats, Neighborhood Improvement Program (NIP) areas, bike routes, cemetery plots, and much more.




Search for a property in the City of Monterey using a parcel number, address, place name, or clicking on the map. Returned results include jurisdiction information (neighborhood, police beat, etc.), zoning information, and a map.

## Follow the 3 steps shown below:



The popup shows the Backwater Valve information on file. Click on the Sewer Laterals tab to view that information for the property.



Another option is to click on the "Details" button in the table below the map, after a property search has been run.



From the Details page, in the "Addresses on Property" box, click on an address to see the same popup with Backwater Valve and Sewer Lateral information.
